2011 OPEN Tournament Rules and Regulations

ENTRY DEADLINES

Entries will open November 1st and close December 11th @ 4:00.

ELIGIBILITY

All entrants must have a 2011-12 USBC Membership card or receipt. All Mid-Minnesota Association members will be eligible to participate in the Open tournament. Bowler must have at least 12 games in the current season or 21 games for the previous season in the Mid-Minnesota USBC Association to be eligible.

AVERAGES

Highest Standard or Adjusted Sport League Average Shall Be Used

Tournament entering average shall be the highest 2010-11 USBC certified average for 21 games or more.

Bowlers with no previous season's average shall use their current average of 12 games or more as of December 3, 2011. All others will bowl scratch of 220 (USBC Rule 319b).

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler, team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average. If submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. (USBC Rule 319a-3)

TEAM BOWLING UNOPPOSED

The following applies when a team or individual is scheduled alone:

- Games must be bowled as though they were contested.
- Each player must complete a frame on one Lane before the player bowling lead off starts the next frame on the adjoining lane.

HANDICAP/SCRATCH

The scratch average shall be 220 with 90% handicap. Bowlers with averages in excess of scratch will use the scratch average – no negative handicap shall be employed. Handicap shall be based on the sum of the individual handicaps for the bowlers.

AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT

10-pin average increase rule (USBC Rule 319a-2) will be in effect.

PARTICIPATION

TEAM - Multiple entries is allowed in this event with the change of two players (or the team can place once in the top 15 places).

DBLS & SGLS - Multiple participation is allowed for these events. Must change partner (or same partners can place once in the top 15). Bowler must register for both doubles and singles.

PRIZE PAYOFF

All prize money will be returned 100%. All prizes awarded on a handicap basis. Prize ratio of 1 for every 4 entries in Team, Doubles, and Singles. Prize ratio for all events is 1 in 10 entries. Plaques will be awarded to the tournament & scratch winners in each event.

NOTE: All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
