2011 Women's Tournament Rules and Regulations

ENTRY DETAILS

Entries will open October 1, 2011 and close November 19 at 5:00 PM. Entries will be scheduled according to requests or in the order received and will not be changed by the tournament manager except for an emergency. If a team is scheduled alone on a pair of lanes, the team shall complete one frame on one lane before starting the next frame on the adjoining lane.

ELIGIBILITY

All entrants must have a 2011-12 USBC Membership card or receipt. Bowler must have at least 12 games in the current season or 21 games for the previous season in the Mid-Minnesota USBC Association to be eligible.

AVERAGES

Last year's highest final average of 21 games or more in one league will be used as average. If a bowler does not have a last year average of 21 games, she will use her current summer league average. If no summer league average, she shall bring a verification of her CURRENT average of at least 12 games at the time she comes to bowl. A bowler without a 12 game average may bowl scratch. Rule 319a.2 regarding use of a current average that is 10 pins or more higher than prior season's average does **NOT** apply. Rule 319e regarding average adjustment based on tournament scores for the 12 months preceding tournament will apply.

CHECK IN

In the team event, the captain checks in the entire team 30 minutes prior to their scheduled bowling time. All bowlers in doubles/singles events must check in with the tournament manager 30 minutes prior to bowling time.

HANDICAP/SCRATCH

Tournament handicap will be 90% of the difference between 215 and the highest league average.

PARTICIPATION

TEAM - Bowlers may bowl in the team event as often as they want, however, not more than three people on one team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. Made-up/Impromptu teams are permitted, but team average cannot exceed 1125 scratch. When a bowler competes more than once, her **FIRST APPEARANCE** in **TEAM** event shall count toward her all events score. All events must be **PAID** prior to your **FIRST EVENT**.

DOUBLES/SINGLES - Entrants in the doubles event must enter the singles event and vice versa. Singles are bowled immediately following doubles. If one bowler is late for the doubles event, the entrant present may bowl her singles event first. If her partner has not arrived by the time the singles event is finished, and a substitute is not available, she will be permitted to bowl her games in the doubles event in order to qualify for all events.

SUBSTITUTES

Substitutes are allowed when replacement is necessary. The tournament manager must be advised of substitutions at least one hour before the scheduled time. In case of an emergency, after the game has started, a substitute shall be allowed in the team and doubles events only. The combined scores are to count in either of these events. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fee will be \$20.00 per bowler per event (team, doubles, and singles). Optional all events fee is \$2.00. After entries have been received and the dates assigned by the tournament manager, the fees shall not be refunded.

PRIZE PAYOUT

Prize money paid into team, doubles, and singles events will be returned one per three entries with all events paying one per ten entries. Scratch and handicap plaques/trophies will be awarded. The same bowler may win both trophies in an event. When ties occur, the prize money and trophies will be distributed to all the teams.

NOTE: Any protest affecting eligibility or playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament manager before the tournament prize payments are made. Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament manager within 24 hours. The Tournament Committee of the Mid-Minnesota USBC shall decide any questions not covered by these tournament rules. The board shall have power to hear and act on all protests arising from or under construction of the rules of the tournament. Tournament games cannot be re-bowled, except as authorized by the tournament manager when scores are irretrievably lost in the scoring process.
