2011 Youth Tournament Rules and Regulations

ENTRY DETAILS

Entries will open October 1, 2011 and close November 26 at 2:30 PM.

ELIGIBILITY

All participants must be a member of the Mid-MN USBC Association. Bowlers must have at least 12 games bowled within the Mid-MN USBC. Proper dress code will be enforced. No hats/caps may be worn during competition.

AVERAGES

Entering averages will be the highest current certified USBC average as of November 19, 2011 with a minimum of 12 games. If there is still no average, a 200 average will be used. Please provide a league average sheet with the entry form in order to verify current average. The coach or league official is responsible for making sure the highest average is used. Bowlers are subject to disqualification if incorrect averages are submitted. Rule 318 will apply.

CHECK IN

Recommended check-in time is 30 minutes prior to scheduled time.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fee will be \$12.00 per bowler per event (team, doubles, and singles).

Optional Scratch Singles Event:

The bowler may elect to bowl in the optional scratch singles event by paying an additional \$5.00/person prior to bowling their singles event.

DIVISIONS

TEAM EVENT

Teams will consist of 4 players. Teams will be placed in the appropriate division based on the combined averages of the bowlers on the team.

Multiple entries are allowed in the Team Event with a change of at least Two Bowlers.

Division 1 – 451 and over
Division 2 – 450 and under

Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the combined averages and 900.

DOUBLES EVENT

Combined averages of the doubles participants will determine their division. Any gender combination may bowl as Doubles Partners.

Multiple entries are allowed in the Doubles Event, but may place only once with the same partner.

Division 1 - 251 and over
Division 2 - 250 and under

Handicap will be 95% of the difference between the combined averages and 450.

SINGLES EVENT

Boys and Girls event for each division.

Multiple entries are allowed in the Singles Event, but may place only once on the prize list.

Division 1 - 126 and over
Division 2 - 125 and under

Handicap will be 95% of the difference between the average and 225 for singles and

PRIZE PAYOUT

All prize money will be returned 100% in the form of scholarships deposited into the SMART program with the USBC. Scholarships will be awarded per division, based on the number of entries per division. At least one scholarship per division will be awarded. Plaques will be awarded for 1st Place in each division. Scholarships will be awarded on a ratio of 1:3.

Note: All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
